

# David "Quaker" Holt

David Holt was born in 1756 to David Holt (1710 - 1784) and Catherine Bradberry (1731 - 1797).

David Holt (c. 1765–30-5-1846) was a Quaker cotton manufacturer from Manchester, England, who married Catherine Lawrence (1758 – 27-6-1824) at Warrington on 19 December 1787 and had at least 13 children. He lived from c. 1765 until his death in 1846, and records indicate he was born in Cheshire and buried in Manchester, Greater Manchester. He married Rebuke Benwell 28 December 1826.

- **Birth and Family:** Born around 1765 in Cheshire, England, his parents were David Holt and Catherine Bradberry. He married Catherine Lawrence in Warrington, Lancashire, in 1787. They had at least 13 children, consisting of seven sons and six daughters.
- **Death:** Holt passed away in 1846 in Greater Manchester, England, at the age of approximately 82. He was buried in Manchester.
- **Occupation:** He was a cotton manufacturer, based in Manchester.
