

°HOLT of Bury St. Edmund's

ARMS: Quarterly of 8,—1 and 8, *Argent, on a bend engrailed Sable three fleurs de lis of the field* (Holt). 2, *Argent, three boars in pale Sable (two and one in the mouth of each a piece of gristle. Vis. of Lanc. 1533, Chetham Soc.)* (Gristlehurst). 3, *Argent a chevron Sable between three towers Gules* (Sumpter). 4, *Vair, a bend Gules* (Brookhole). 5, *Argent three water bougets Gules* (Roos). 6, *Ermine a fess dancettée Gules*. 7, *Argent two chevrons Azure a label of three points Gules*.

CREST: *An arm erect couped at the elbow habited per pale Azure and Gules, in the hand Argent a pheon Sable.*
