HOLT, JOHN, Esq. of Stubbylee, co. Lancaster, *b.* 22 Aug. 1804; *m.* 25 June, 1828, Judith, third dau. of James Maden, Esq. of Greens, in the same county, and has issue,

I. JAMES-MADEN, *b.* 18 Oct. 1829.

I. Julia-Anne-Elizabeth. II. Emily-Sarah.

Mr. Holt is a magistrate for Lancashire and for the West Riding of Yorkshire.

### Lineage.

JOHN HOLT, settled at Stubbylee about the middle of the 18th century. He *m.* Alice, dau. of Mr. Pilling, of Bury, co. Lancaster, and was *s.* at his decease by his son.

JAMES HOLT, Esq. of Stubbylee, *b.* 9 March, 1755, who *m.* 1st, in Jan. 1790, Jenny, dau. of Timothy Hoyle, Gent. of Lee, and 2ndly, 9 Sept. 1803, Anne, dau. of James Heyworth, Esq. of Greensnook, and by the latter only, who *d.* 4 Feb. 1819, had issue an only child, JOHN.

*Arms*—Arg., on a bend, engr., sa., three fleurs-de-lis, of the first.

*Crest*—A dexter arm, embowed, in armour, ppr., garnished, or, holding in the gauntlet a pheon, sa.

*Seat*—Stubbylee, co. Lancaster.
