Will 19th December 1608 ROBTE HOLTE the yonger of Assheworth Co Lanc, gentleman buriall in the parish Church of Middleton my desire is that the Reckoninge betweane me and my Fellow executors concerninge the wiffe and children of Richard Holte late of Franckecotes deceased shalbee cleared

I give

to Richard Holte my eldest sonne the gilte nutt which was my first wives And I give the guilte goblett and and sixe apostle spoones which weare intended by my grandfather Cartsyde to continewe as heireloomes unto my said sonne Richard after the decease of my Father and for the inheritance as welk of my father as my self which is and is ment to bee left in my fathers power

I commend

my sonne Richard and in defecte of him ^{my} ~~any~~ sonne Robte Holte to bee so intreated by him as shalbee agreeable to the covenantes of my mariage made betweene Sr Richard Assheton Knight of thone ptie and my Father of thother ptie (onely excepted reasonable pferment of Robte and Marie my yonger children

to Robte Holte my sonne my guilte Silver Boule unto Marie Holte my daughter that litle Jewell of gold

unto evye of the Daughters of my wiffe by John Hopwood
gent deceased except Marie the wiffe of Francis
Chadwicke everie one 20/- my will is that my Executor
shall deliver

unto Edmonde Hopwood my wives sonne by her former husband
two guilt silver spones

unto my Father in Lawe St Richard Assheton Knight and to
my Suster the Ladie Marie Assheton his wiffe and to
my brother in Lawe John Holte esqur and to my Cosen
Robte Heywood of Heywood gentleman evrie one 10/- in
gould to bee made into Rings

unto Evrie one of the children of the said Ladie Marie
Assheton my suster 5/-

unto my brother William Holte the Lawer ~~my~~ my graye stond
horse and to my suster in Lawe his wiffe 5/- in gould
to my suster in Lawe Mrs Elizabeth Holte 5/-

Father in consideration that hee doe delivr

to Dorothie Holte my wiffe my balde nagge and doe make
up the vallew of him and of all goodes as she can claime
for her portion to £100 alwaies Remembered that I intend
nothings of that third pte of Brandlesome intended for
John Greenehalgh my nephewe but that it maie bee
disposed of by my Father as hee shall thinke good And
where I doubt that my abillities thus disposed wilbee
ffarre to short to afforde my yonger children competent
preferment I desire my said Father Robte Holte to supplie
them out of these landes whereof I trust him with

Sole Executor the said Robte Holte of Assheworth esquire
my father my father in lawe and Brother in Lawe Sr
Richard Assheton Knight and John Holte esquir Oversiers
